



JOB DESCRIPTION

LEISURE/MOORINGS OPERATIVE

This is a full time, permanent position working a 40-hour week (Monday to Friday 08:00 to 16:30) for Fowey Harbour Commissioners, based both ashore and afloat.

This is a varied, hands-on and physical role which will involve the operation of boats and lifting equipment. Mooring maintenance is carried out over the winter period and involves outdoor working in all weather conditions.

Seasonal overtime, including weekend work, will be required on a rota basis during the summer period for Harbour Patrol duties. This uniformed position is a high profile and responsible role, it is largely afloat, patrolling Fowey Harbour, policing and assisting harbour users and visiting yachts.

An additional, occasional role as a tug deckhand is also available (subject to successful completion of training).

The successful candidate will be highly motivated and flexible, with the ability to use their own initiative to work alone without supervision when required. They will be able to communicate confidently and effectively to the general public as well as to other staff.

The main roles and responsibilities will include:
(although established skills are preferred, training is available)

- Boat handling
- Towing and berthing visiting boats
- HIAB and winch operation
- Boat crane operation and banksmen duties
- Harbour Patrol

Preferably the successful applicant will hold a RYA Powerboat Level 2 qualification (minimum) and a Marine VHF Radio Licence

A competitive salary package accompanies the post and will reflect experience.
