### Pontoon Restrictions during Cruise Ship Visits

As part of the harbour's compliance with the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code, security measures will be enforced at the Albert Quay pontoon during the visit of cruise ships to the port. In the event of Albert Quay pontoon being unavailable, an alternative landing may be used at Berrill's Yard pontoon.

Portions of the pontoons will be reserved for cruise ship tender operations which will reduce space on the outside section for yachts and access to the boarding area will be restricted.

As the pontoons fall within the temporary restricted zones, a pass system will be in operation. Those coming ashore from yachts will be issued with a pass which enables re-entry into the secure zone. It should be noted that only those with valid passes will be allowed entry.

Fowey Harbour Commissioners staff will endeavor to ensure that these necessary restrictions have as minimal impact as is reasonably practicable. Advance notification of the use of the alternative landing at Berrill's Yard pontoon will be given where possible. Thank you for your co-operation.
