HARBOUR MASTER'S NOTICE

2026/09

Use of FHC Rental Moorings by Visiting Vessels at Peak Periods

As a Statutory Harbour Authority (SHA), Fowey Harbour Commissioners have a duty to ensure that vessels arriving in the Port are moored safely. To this end, visitor mooring facilities and unused rental moorings, on occasion, are utilised throughout the season.

There are times, however, when the numbers of craft require the Harbour Master to use his powers of direction and berth visiting vessels on rented resident moorings / alongside resident boats. This is to ensure continued port safety.

The times when this direction is necessary are isolated and rare; however, there is the possibility that it may be required again this year.

This will mainly affect those licensees in Pont Pill and Polruan Pool; however, all mooring licensees are asked to cooperate with Fowey Harbour Patrol during these peak times.

Any directions issued by Harbour Patrol must be followed.
