HARBOUR MASTER'S NOTICE

2026/16

Working Boat Harbour Race Thursday 20th August

Harbour users are advised that the working boat harbour race is due to take place in the lower harbour on Thursday 20th August from 1430-1600.

This notice supplements the race instructions issued to competitors and provides safety instructions regarding restricted zones.

Start and Finish Line: In line with Albert Quay, finishing from north to south.

Harbour Mouth Mark: A race mark moored mid-stream in the harbour mouth.

Upstream Turning Mark: A race mark moored mid-stream, north of Albert Quay pontoon.

Course: As directed by the Race Officer.

Restricted Zone: In the interests of safety to other harbour users and competing boats, the race is confined to the fairway; vessels racing may not enter the moorings except in emergency. Boats may pass east of the swing buoy (except when finishing), if safe to do so, but must keep outside of the yellow 'flat top' V Moorings to the south of the swing buoy (see *chartlet overleaf*). In the event that any competing craft does enter a restricted zone the Race Officer will determine whether a craft is to be disqualified. Other protests will be within the rules of the Regatta.
