Torchlight Procession and Firework Display

Harbour users are advised that the **Torchlight Procession** will take place on Saturday 23rd August. Participating boats will assemble off Passage Slip for 2100 and proceed slowly down river to the swinging area off Town Quay. The **Firework Display** will then take place in the lower harbour at 2145.

Due to high volumes of boat traffic expected on the water, large ship movements will be suspended and port operations will be restricted between Caffa Mill and Whitehouse Quay from 2100-2230.

Harbour Patrol will be in attendance for the duration of the event and contactable via VHF Ch.12. Participants must comply with their instructions. In the event of an incident, the nearest Harbour Patrol vessel will provide assistance.

TORCHLIGHT PROCESSION

- Participants should ensure that torches are of the chemical type.
- Naked flames are **NOT** permitted.
- **DO NOT** LET OFF DISTRESS FLARES.

FIREWORK DISPLAY

Vessels are advised to moor up for the duration of the display, but if underway, they must maintain a vigilant look out to avoid collision.

Resident and visiting vessels moored close to the display site are advised to check their vessels for falling debris immediately after the display to prevent risk of damage.
