Applications are sought for the position of Fowey Harbour Commissioner to be appointed from May 2026, in accordance with the Fowey Harbour Revision Orders 1937-2021.

Fowey Harbour is a Trust Port with a busy commercial sector and is a popular leisure area for both residential and visiting boats. The primary role of the Board of volunteer Commissioners is to shape the strategy and management of the Harbour for the benefit of harbour users and other stakeholders.

This position is without remuneration. Monthly meetings are held together with occasional other commitments.

New appointments are made following a selection and interview process. The selection panel is formed by the Chair of the Board and may include other Commissioners and harbour stakeholders.
